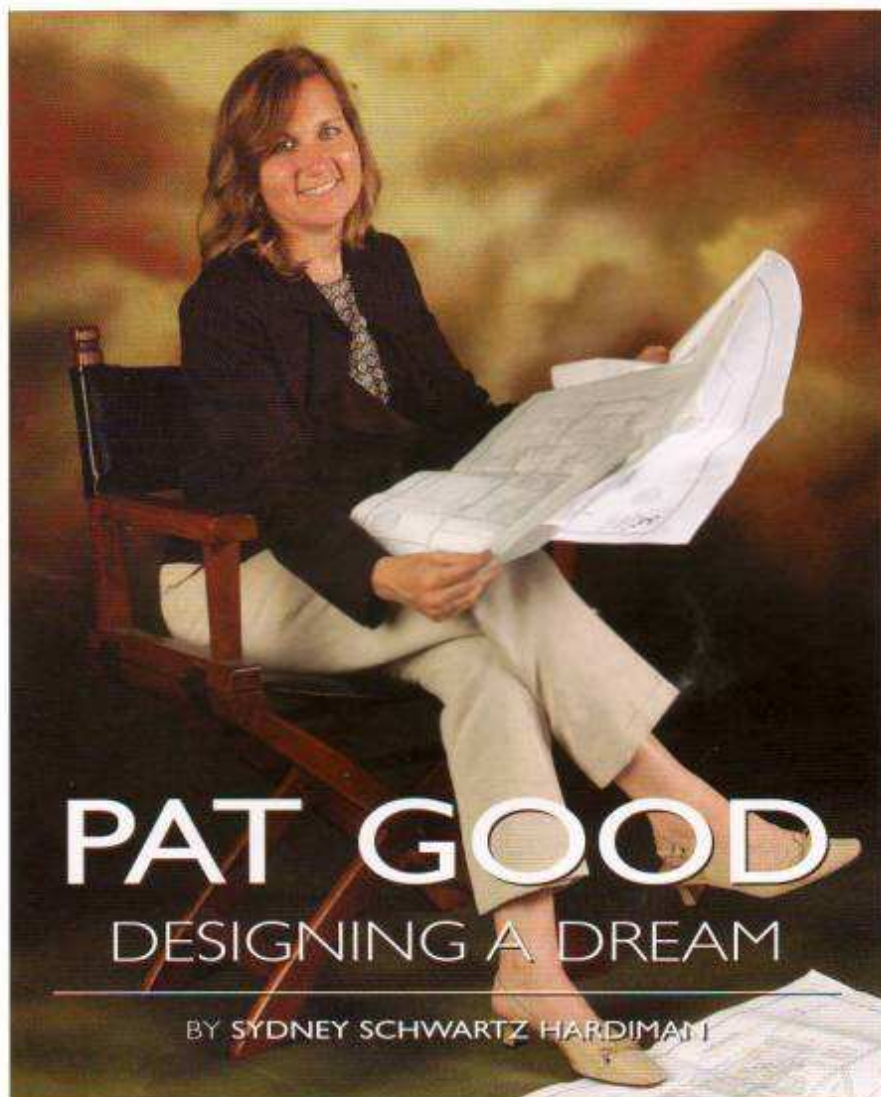


DESIGNER PROFILE
